

**TENDER**  
**Development of E-Training Application**

**Purpose of the Project / Call**

Transparency International-Greece, the greek Chapter of Transparency International, and Super League Hellas have joined forces on an 18 month project "Staying on Side: How to Stop Match-Fixing"<sup>1</sup> to help prevent match-fixing through education and awareness-raising. The project has been funded with support from the European Commission – Directorate General Education and Culture. (Project No. EAC-2012-0568).

As part of the project, TI-Greece would like to develop an e-training application for young people (age 17-20 years old), who are interested in football (young players, fans etc) to train them on how to avoid being part of match-fixing.

**Deadline for offer submission: 15/10/2013**

**Selection Criteria**

Winning offers will be selected by a panel of TI-Greece staff and management. Applications submitted under this Call for Offers will be assessed against the following criteria:

1. Experience in the field of the service (30 points)
2. Time of delivery (20 points)
3. Bid price (50 points)
